2. What do the passages above teach us about:
  - The symbolism of the bread.
  - The symbolism of the cup & wine.
  - The reason we still observe the Lord's Supper.
  - The kingdom of God that is coming.

## **L I F E A P P L I C A T I O N**

1. Paul instructs us in 1 Corinthians 11 to examine ourselves before we receive the Lord's Supper. What does it mean to "examine" yourself?
2. What does the way we are instructed to approach the Lord's Supper teach us about God's desire for our personal purity?
3. If you bring a non-Christian to church on a day we observe the Lord's Supper, what could you say to prepare them for what they are going to observe? How could you use the Lord's Supper as an opportunity to share the Gospel with them?
