### **G a l a t i a n s 1 : 1 - 2 4**

Read Galatians 1:1-24 and discuss the following questions.

- 1) What do we learn about Christ from Paul's greeting in verses 1 through 5? What elements of the gospel does Paul mention in his greeting?
- 2) What concern does Paul address in verses 6 through 10? How does he address it?
- 3) How does Paul's argument in verses 11-24 support his statement: "the gospel that was preached by me is not man's gospel." How does Paul set the gospel of Christ apart from the false gospels of man?

## **L I F E A P P L I C A T I O N**

- 1) How well do you know the gospel? If given the opportunity, could you share the gospel in 5 minutes with someone?
- 2) Paul was writing to address concerns about a "different gospel" that was being preached. What "different gospels" are being preached today?
- 3) How should we respond to people who follow a "different gospel"?
- 4) What can you do to be better prepared to defend the gospel of Christ against the many false gospels that we see in our culture today?
