Galatians 6:3-7 If anyone thinks he is something when he is nothing, he deceives himself. **4** Each one should test his own actions. Then he can take pride in himself, without comparing himself to somebody else, **5** for each one should carry his own load. **6** Anyone who receives instruction in the word must share all good things with his instructor. **7** Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows.

Galatians 6:8-10 The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature will reap destruction; the one who sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. **9** Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. **10** Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.
